Agreement

between

the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Slovenia

and

the Ministry of Defence of Montenegro
on Donation of Self-propelled Aiming Radar SNAR-10

The Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Slovenia and

the Ministry of Defence of Montenegro

Hereinafter referred to as "the Parties",

Desiring to enhance bilateral cooperation between the Republic of Slovenia and Montenegro,

Based on Article 3 of the Agreement on Cooperation in the Field of Defence between the Government of the Republic of Montenegro and the Government of the Republic of Slovenia, signed in Ljubljana on June 18, 2007.

Having regard to the provisions of the Agreement between the Parties to the North Atlantic Treaty regarding the Status of their Forces (NATO SOFA), done at London on June 19, 1951;

Have agreed on the following:

Article 1

The purpose of this Agreement is to define mutual relations, rights and obligations of the Parties with regard to the donation of the Ministry of Defence of Montenegro (hereinafter referred to as Donating Party) to the Ministry of Defence of the Republic of Slovenia (hereinafter referred to as Receiving Party).

Article 2

- 1. The object of the donation is a museum exhibit Self-propelled aiming radar SNAR-10 (chassis number 08363, engine number 502996) (hereinafter referred to as the object of the donation), which is located in the barracks "Pero Ćetković" in Bar, Montenegro.
- 2. The estimated value of the object of the donation is 11.900,00 €.

Article 3

The object of the donation is handed over in "as is" condition in terms of completeness and functionality and can be used exclusively as a museum exhibit item.

Article 4

- 1. The handover of the object of the donation shall take place in the barracks "Pero Ćetković" in Bar, Montenegro.
- 2. The day of handover of the object of the donation shall be determined by the Parties immediately upon the signature of this Agreement and after acquiring the necessary documents and permits for transport execution.

Article 5

1. The Receiving Party shall bear the costs of loading and transport of the object of the donation.

- 2. Both Parties shall assure necessary documents and permits for export/import procedures and execution of the transport of the objects of the donation to the Republic of Slovenia.
- 3. The payment of taxes, import and export duties and taxes, including VAT, shall be conducted in accordance with the national legislation of the Republic of Slovenia and Montenegro.

Article 6

The technical and operational procedural elements shall be defined in a separate document.

Article 7

This Agreement may be amended at any time by the mutual written consent of the Parties.

Article 8

This Agreement may be terminated by either Party giving one-month prior written notice. The Parties shall consult to determine how any outstanding matters should be dealt with.

Article 9

Any disputes that may arise during the implementation of this Agreement shall be settled through consultations and direct negotiations between the Parties.

Article 10

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of its signature.
