## **Introduction**

hereinafter referred to as the contributing Members (cMs), as well as the European Defence Agency (hereinafter referred to as “EDA” or the “Agency”), hereinafter referred to collectively as “Participants”;

Considering the Treaty on European Union tasking EDA, inter alia, to promote harmonisation of operational needs and the adoption of effective, compatible procurement methods (Article 45 paragraph 1 b TEU);

Considering Protocol (No. 7) on the privileges and immunities of the European Union, annexed to the Treaty on European Union and to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union, and made applicable to EDA by Article 27.3 of the Council Decision;

Considering the Council Decision (CFSP) 2015/1835 of 12 October 2015 defining the statute, seat and operational rules of the European Defence Agency (hereinafter referred to as “the Council Decision”) tasks the Agency in its Article 5 paragraph 3 to promote and enhance European cooperation in particular, to promote cost-effective and efficient procurement by identifying and disseminating best practices. Moreover, it contains rules on how to launch cooperative ad-hoc projects or programmes of groups of Member States and on how to entrust the Agency with the management of such projects or programmes (Article 17 and Chapter IV);

Considering the Council Decision (EU) 2016/1353 of 4 August 2016 concerning the financial rules of the European Defence Agency and repealing Decision 2007/643/CFSP (hereinafter referred to as “the EDA Financial Rules”);

Considering the Council Decision 2013/488/EU of 23 September 2013 on the security rules for protecting EU Classified information;

Considering the Council Directive 112/2006/EC of 28 November 2006 on the common system of value added tax, notably Article 151 (1) (aa) as referred to by the Council Decision in recital (18);

Considering that, in accordance with chapter IV of the Council Decision, the EDA Steering Board endorsed on 19 February 2021 the Outline Description No 1056 establishing the present Project Arrangement (PA) as an EDA Project Arrangement;

Considering the Directive 2014/24/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 February 2014 on public procurement and repealing Directive 2004/18/EC;

have reached the following understanding concerning this EMAR Training Category A Project, hereinafter referred to as “the Project”.

### **Section 1. Aim and Objectives**

- 1.1. The Project will support a unified approach by all cMs as regards the implementation and application of EMARs within the national airworthiness systems through the establishment of a common EMAR TP for staff of NMAAs.
- 1.2. The objectives of the Project are the following:
  - a) to develop and maintain a common training syllabus and course curriculum for both Initial and Continuation Training for NMAA staff;
  - b) to provide a recurring course schedule based on the needs of all cMs to equip trainees with an in-depth understanding of:
    - (i) the EMAR-concept, the function of EMARs in the context of the sovereignty of cMs and the main differences with the civil (EASA) regulatory framework;
    - (ii) the individual EMARs, their intended use and application as well as the related oversight aspects;
  - c) to provide for a structural platform to exchange views and opinions between staff of NMAAs;
  - d) to promote the implementation and harmonised application of EMARs based on a joint view by the MAWA Forum.
- 1.3. The Project will involve a common training baseline and syllabus for NMAA staff of all cMs, a high level of efficiency through a single service provider and maximum economy of scale for the training of staff. Finally, the Project will support a harmonised and consistent implementation of an airworthiness system based on EMARs, which enables a smooth exchange of aviation products and airworthiness data between cMs.

### **Section 2. Participation**

- 2.1. This Project is open to pMS, as well as Third Countries with an Administrative Arrangement as referred in Article 26 of the Council Decision and that are entitled to take part in EDA’s ad hoc activities pursuant to Articles 19 and 23 of the Council Decision.

### **Section 3. Project Management Group (PMG)**

- 3.1. A PMG will be established to implement this PA. Each cM will designate a PoC and a deputy for the PMG, who will act as authorised representative to exchange any

communication related to this PA.<sup>1</sup> Each cM will inform EDA on any change of its PoCs during the duration of this PA. Such changes will not require an amendment of the PA. The PMG will be supported by EDA.

- 3.2. The PMG is responsible for the management of the activities under this PA, in particular:
- a) providing support and inputs to EDA in the preparation of potential amendments to this PA;
  - b) taking such decisions as necessary to comply with any applicable provision of this PA;
  - c) the development and maintenance of the Project Management Plan (PMP), including the operational and financial aspects;
  - d) providing inputs for the contractual requirements of the EMAR TP such as, but not limited to:
    - (i) technical requirements for the tendering procedure for the establishment of the required framework contract ("FWC");
    - (ii) subjects to be addressed in the training material;
    - (iii) the annual quantitative training needs for each EMAR with a view to the establishment of the annual Specific Contracts;
    - (iv) assessing and accepting the contract deliverables;
    - (v) approving the annual training plan, including the allocation of training places for each cM;
    - (vi) approving the annual training calendar;
  - e) instruct EDA to sign contract(s) related to this PA on behalf of the cMs with the Contractor and any amendment thereof;
  - f) on the basis of the audited annual financial report, approve the report and grant the discharge to the Accounting Officer each year, as necessary, and when applicable;
  - g) monitoring the progress of the EMAR TP and report annually to the MAWA Forum Executives of the cMs.
- 3.3. Unless stated otherwise in this PA, the PMG will reach their decisions by consensus, meaning a unanimous position or majority position with no objections. In this respect, each cM has one vote while EDA is without voting rights.
- 3.4. Should the PMG fail to reach a decision by consensus, the matter at stake will be referred to the EDA Steering Board.

- 3.5. Generally, the PMG will be chaired by a PoC of one of the cMs as selected by the group, following an election based on a majority vote. For this purpose, the cMs will be invited to propose candidates ultimately one month before the election will be held. In case cMs are not able to provide a Chair, EDA will chair the meetings of the PMG – whether or not for an interim period – to ensure continuity of the EMAR TP, if so agreed by cMs.
- 3.6. Meetings of the PMG will be conducted at least twice a year or as required to enable the timely provisioning of guidance, updates, reports and exchanges of views. The Contractor as well as potential new cMs may be invited.

#### **Section 4. Role of EDA**

##### 4.1. EDA will:

- a) in accordance with Section 3, attend the meetings of the PMG without voting rights;
- b) host and arrange meetings of the PMG, including preparation of the agenda and the minutes;
- c) assign a Project Officer (PO) who is responsible for the effective coordination of the EMAR TP;
- d) collect the annual training needs of and coordinate the annual training calendar with cMs;
- e) prepare the budget forecasts in coordination with cMs and prepare the management decisions for the PMG;
- f) cooperate with the PMG in drafting an annual report to the MAWA Forum Executives of the cMs;
- g) perform the tasks in relation to procurement and contracting as set forth under Section 7;
- h) perform the tasks in relation to financial management as set forth under Section 8;
- i) prepare any potential amendments to this PA in coordination with cMs.

#### **Section 5. Reporting**

- 5.1. The PMG will draft, in cooperation with the PO, an annual report concerning the EMAR TP activities to be presented to the MAWA Forum Executives of the cMs. In the penultimate year of the FWC period, the annual report will contain advice on the continuation of the EMAR TP under a new FWC based on an evaluation of the TP effectiveness and the possible TP improvements that are considered necessary.

**Section 6. Project Management Plan**

- 6.1. For the management of the EMAR TP, a PMP will be developed and maintained by the PMG. The PMP will include an overview of all necessary management and annual training activities, their timelines, the allocation of training places for each cMs, the required budget and budget contributions by each cMs for the next calendar (X+1) year as well as a budgetary forecast for the succeeding 2 calendar years (X+2, X+3).

**Section 7. Procurement and Contract Management**

- 7.1. Procedures launched under this PA will be administered in compliance with provisions of Directive 2014/24/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 February 2014 on public procurement and repealing Directive 2004/18/EC.
- 7.2. Procedural issues not detailed in the Directive 2014/24/EU will be addressed by the Agency's Financial and Procurement rules adopted under (EU) 2016/1353 of 4 August 2016.
- 7.3. Following the launch of an open call for tender EDA will aim to establish one FWC. The estimated total value of the FWC under this PA will be EUR 200 000 (two hundred thousand euro, including a fixed cost for the development and maintenance (e.g. updates) of the training estimated at 20.000 Eur).
- 7.4. The cMs acting through their authorized representatives in the PMG will be able to request training services through a jointly established service request to EDA.
- 7.5. All orders concluded under the FWC will be issued by EDA, via Specific Contracts that are based on the jointly established service requests from the PMG.

**Section 8. Financial Provisions**

- 8.1. The cMs hereby acknowledge that:
- a) the EMAR TP is an EDA Project under the meaning of Article 19 of the Council Decision;
  - b) the EDA's role in administering the EMAR TP in support of the cMs brings an added value to them;
  - c) all sourced services under this PA and the subsequent FWC qualify for VAT exemption in accordance with Article 27.3 of the Council Decision.
- 8.2. Payments associated with the implementation of the PA through the conclusion of a FWC and subsequent Specific Contracts will be handled by EDA in accordance with its financial rules.
- 8.3. Each cMs will be responsible for the costs of its own national contribution to this PA and related costs generated by it, notably:

- a) its equal share of the cost for the development and maintenance (e.g. updates) of EMAR training modules;
  - b) costs for training courses of their trainees;
  - c) administrative and support cost related to participation of trainings by trainees (e.g. travel, accommodation and subsistence);
  - d) any cost incurred by the work of the PoCs mentioned in Section 3.
- 8.4. The cost for the development and maintenance (e.g. updates) of the EMAR training modules will be equally shared by all cMs that require training services during the FWC period. New cMs and cMS that require training services at a later stage in the FWC period and initially have not contributed to the cost for the development and maintenance of the training modules, will pay a one-off contribution fee to compensate the cMs that have paid their share of these cost. This one-off contribution fee will be equal to the total development and maintenance cost up to their point of participation in training services, divided by the new total number of cMs. The compensation amounts for the other cMs will be deducted from their new financial commitments. Any surplus amounts will be returned to the cMs at the end of the FWC period.
- 8.5. The contributions of cMs related to the training courses will be calculated based on the allocated training places to their trainees as decided by the PMG in accordance with Section 3.2.
- 8.6. cMs will have the option to transfer funds per Specific Contract or to transfer funds in advance for services to be provided at a later stage.
- 8.7. The Project will be funded from the Ad Hoc Budget made up from cMs contributions. The contributions by the cMs will be paid into a dedicated interest-bearing bank account (Ad-Hoc Bank Account) managed by EDA in order to allow centralised payment by EDA of invoices arising from activities conducted and accepted within the Project. Payments into the Ad-Hoc Bank Account will be made in EURO. A single call for contributions, corresponding to payments to be made during the reference period, will be made by EDA to the NBPAs as listed in Annex A. cMs will make their payments within sixty (60) calendar days of receiving the call for contribution. The contributions are due within 60 days following entry into force of each specific contract. Where necessary, EDA may issue additional calls for contributions after having consulted the PMG. Throughout the PA, cMs will ensure that they have transferred to the Ad-Hoc Bank Account sufficient funds to enable EDA to fulfil its contractual payment obligations to Contractor(s) in a timely manner. Contractual liability arising from late payments to Contractor(s) because EDA did not have sufficient funds on Ad-Hoc Bank Account will be borne by cMs responsible for delayed payments. Payments to the Contractor and co-contractors by EDA will be made no

later than 60/90 days<sup>2</sup> from the date of receipt of the invoices. Any payments by EDA will be managed in accordance with the EDA Financial Rules.

- 8.8. The PMG will inform EDA as to the satisfactory completion of the tasks and milestones defined in the contract (by means of a template acceptance form in Annex B to be submitted to EDA no later than 15 days from the date of acceptance) and will instruct EDA to execute contractually agreed payment. EDA will then forward to the Contractor(s) the acceptance form and request for invoices to be sent out. EDA will pay invoices from the EDA Ad Hoc Bank Account.
- 8.9. cMs may request the return of any uncommitted surplus budget, including accrued interest if any. If a cM does not make this request, any surplus funds will be returned to it after the termination of the FWC provided that it is not replaced by a new one.
- 8.10. An audited financial report will be provided by EDA on an annual basis. The audited annual accounts will be submitted to the PMG for approval.
- 8.11. National audit authorities of cMs may, upon request, at their own cost and without infringing on the rights of the other cMs or the responsibilities of the EDA College of Auditors, obtain information and inspect any documentation that they deem necessary for auditing their respective national share or reporting to government or parliament.
- 8.12. After completion of this PA, EDA will produce a final financial report detailing all funds and invoices received, payments made and indicating the final balance of the account. This report will be submitted to the PMG for approval. Any unused funds will be returned to the cMs based on their instructions. Interest generated by the funds transferred to the Ad-Hoc Bank Account will be shared between the cMs proportionally to their respective financial contributions unless the cMs decide otherwise. The PMG will inform EDA of the decision of the concerned cMs. In order to facilitate the timely closure of the Ad-Hoc Bank Account, in the absence of a clear instruction from the cMs regarding return of their unused funds and of the related bank interest within one month after reception of the final financial report audit report, EDA will offset the surplus arising from this Project against the annual contribution of the cMs to the EDA general budget.
- 8.13. All administrative costs of this Project will be borne by the cMs incurring them, including inter alia the traveling expenses and costs related to the assignment of their members of the PMG.
- 8.14. EDA will be generally responsible for the various administrative tasks related to the conclusion and subsequent monitoring of the contract(s) concluded by EDA under the Project.

**Section 9. Claims and Liabilities**

- 9.1. All claims and liabilities arising from or in connection with the execution of activities under this PA will be dealt with in accordance with international, European and national laws and regulations of the cMs concerned. All claims and liabilities arising from contracts concluded by EDA on behalf of cMs will be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the relevant contract.

**Section 10. Settlement of Disputes**

- 10.1. This PA does not constitute a treaty under international law. In case of any conflict between this PA and EU or national laws and regulations of the cMs, the latter will prevail. The cMs will notify each other of any conflict between this PA and national law.
- 10.2. Any dispute arising between the cMs and EDA over the interpretation or application of this PA will solely be resolved by consultations.

**Section 11. Security of Information**

- 11.1. The information under this PA is unclassified.

**Section 12. Signature, coming into Effect, Duration and Accession of new cMs**

- 12.1. This PA is signed in one original in an English and a French version, each version being equally valid.
- 12.2. The original will be held by EDA, with one certified true copy being sent to each cM.
- 12.3. This PA and any subsequent amendments will come into effect upon signature by the last Participant, unless stipulated otherwise in said amendment. EDA will be the last Participant to sign off this PA.
- 12.4. The initial duration of this PA is 4 years and will be renewed automatically for another period of 4 years, unless the cMs decide otherwise.
- 12.5. In the event of further Third Countries expressing their wish to become cM of this Project, they can do so in accordance with Section 2 'Participation', by signing a unilateral statement of intent accepting this PA and sending it to EDA<sup>3</sup>, provided that all the formalities governing the participation of entities in EDA's Ad hoc projects and programmes supported by Art. 19 and 23 of the Council Decision have been fulfilled. In such cases this PA will be amended.
- 12.6. A cM can withdraw its participation in this PA by means of a unilateral declaration sent in writing to EDA. Its termination will take effect 3 months after the termination notification.

All commitments undertaken by a cM before the withdrawal date remain in effect also after the termination date.

- 12.7. EDA will notify the other cMs to this PA of any changes of membership within seven days.
- 12.8. Switzerland, in the event of an international armed conflict involving a cM of this PA, will withdraw from all cooperation activities under this PA because of its obligations as a permanent neutral country under the Hague Conventions of 18 October 1907, and in compliance with the provision set under this Section 12.


